## Remember these 3 things



**Keep your contact info up to date**



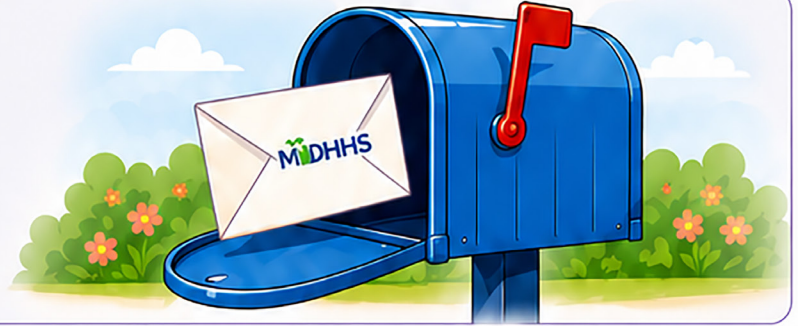
**Renew on time**



**Ask for help early**

## 1 Step 1: Check Your Mail

Watch for a letter from MDHHS. This letter tells you when it is time to renew.



## 2 Step 2: Gather Your Papers

You may need some or all of these:



**ID or proof of age**

- Birth certificate
- Driver's license or state ID



**Income**

- Recent pay stubs
- Tax return
- Social Security or Veteran benefits

**Money in the bank**



- Bank or retirement papers
- A note saying you do not have a bank account

**Citizenship or immigration**



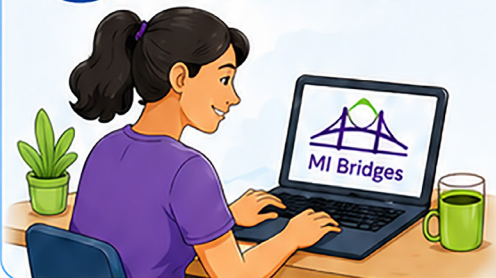
- Birth certificate
- U.S. passport
- USCIS card



**Important:** If MDHHS needs more proof, they will send you a Verification Checklist.
