

## St. Joseph Mercy Ann Arbor and St. Joseph Mercy Livingston Investing in Our Communities Grant Program Foundant System Access and Guidance

The St. Joseph Mercy Ann Arbor and St. Joseph Mercy Livingston grant program will host its application process on the Foundant system (a grant submission and management system that is used across Trinity Health for a variety of externally-facing application processes). The following document provides instructions on how to create an account in the Foundant system and then access the Investing in Our Communities application.

### 1. Accessing the Foundant system
