Block(s)	Rotation	Description
4	Inpatient Adult Medicine Wards	Integrated into IM and FM resident teams. Overnight shifts proportional to host IM/FM residents (night float)
2	Inpatient Medicine Electives	IM, FM, MICU, SICU, CTICU, ID, Gen Surg, Neurosurg, OBGYN, Peds, Cards, Pulm, Neuro, EM, Palliative
2	Emergency Medicine	140 hours required by ACGME
1	Ambulatory Care	IM, FM, Gen Surg, OB/GYN, Pediatrics; 140 hours required by ACGME
4	Electives	Any above OR Anesthesiology, Dermatology, Dermatopathology, Endocrinology, ENT, Forensic Pathology/Research (this is combined), Gastroenterology, Geriatrics, Infectious Disease, Neurology, Ophthalmology, Ortho Surgery, Palliative Medicine, PM&R, Pain Medicine, Psychiatry, Radiology Oncology, Radiology, Research, Sports Medicine, Urology, and others by request
